Empowering Women: Self-Defense Training at KIAP

In a collaborative effort between the KIAP and the Self-Defense Training team from the Kerala Police Department's



Cyber City Police Division in Kazhakkootam, a specialized self-defense training program was organized. A total of 63 participants from various industrial units attended the program. These women were eager to learn practical skills to enhance their safety and confidence


M/s Goodwill Polymers
